South Australian State Championships

The contest was flown during Adelaide Cup weekend of March 7th-9th at the Monarto field, which is a short distance from Murray Bridge.

As this was the first of the qualifying events for F2 selection for the Australian team to compete at the Perth C/L World Championships next year, entry numbers were at an increased level for F2C and F2B and Queensland was the only State not to have a representative present. Graham Christie and Rod Brown came from New Zealand and gained plenty of racing experience and might even have attained a New Zealand F2C race record during the weekend.

For various reasons not all events were flown consequently there are no results for Vintage and Half A Combat or Classic B and Vintage A team Race.

Speed and most of the racing events took place on the concrete circle at the lower side of the club field whilst the Aerobatics were flown on the smooth grass area at the top of the field that is normally used by the R/C flyers. One round of F2B was flown on the concrete circle.

Skin Hinges for Elevators on CL Racing & Speed Models.

At the SA State Champs in early March, a couple of people commented that they'd not previously seen the method that I use to hinge the elevator on my 1/2A Proto/Mini-Goodyear model.

In my case, I vacuum bagged the entire tail plane with fiberglass on the underside, and a cross-weave Kevlar/carbon matt on the top surface. To hinge the elevator, I simply cut through the glass and balsa on the underside, leaving the Kevlar on the top surface intact at the front edge of the elevator. You probably don't even need to use the Kevlar per se on the top surface (i.e. you could use glass if you like), although I do think it's probably less likely to split over time than alternative materials.

Voila - It's about as simple as it gets.

P.S. I take no credit for this approach. I started using it on my R/C pylon models (for elevators, ailerons and rudders) based on information on the Interwebs.

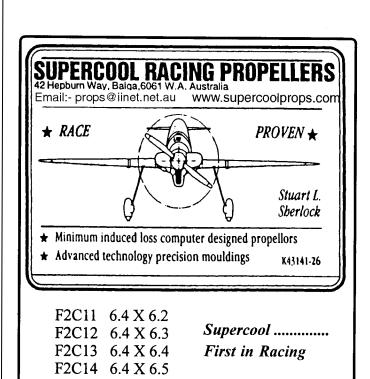
