

By the way Andrew who runs the cooking is a top bloke and a culinary master. Yum Yum.





South Australian State Championships held at Adelaide Model Aerosport, Monarto Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th March 2017

<u>F2C Team Race</u> had 9 teams entered for the contest. Andrew Robinson and brother Brendon had flown over from New Zealand to get some valuable practice against some top teams as they prepared for an entry in the World Championships to be held in France in 2018. This event was the first of the qualifying rounds for the Australian National team.

The Leknys family were well represented as Colin and Shane had made the trip from W.A. and Ryan was teamed up with Julian Reichardt. Trevor Letchford had also made the trip from W.A. and had Neil Baker on hand for pit-man duties. Ken Hunting was campaigning a Sosnovsky junior engine in his model and Harry Bailey was given the pilots duties.

With the current World Championship first and second place holders and the partnership of Richard Justic and Ron Lacey in the mix we had the makings of a very competitive event.

Six of the teams used Lerner engines. Leknys/Leknys used Zalp and Bailey Hunting used a Sosnovsky and a Nelson.

At that stage it was decided to call it a day for F2C and not risk flying a final 200 lap race.



The story does not end there.

As many of you will know, Ray Harvey is an excellent model builder and has in the past produced first class kits and models for sale. Ray has since informed me that he can now offer a new service to modellers providing profiled wings and tailplanes for solid winged models of any design. Here is the information from Ray.

Hi Harry.

As promised, here is the information about my new venture which is now in operation.

I can now produce wings and tailplanes that are shaped on a Computer Numerically Controlled (CNC) router and can be any planform and shaped with any section although I have my favourites. The finish and accuracy of these products has to be seen to be believed.

They have laminated leading edge and reinforced front panel on the outboard wing for catching.

Internal control grooves and bellcrank assembly are also part of the package. They are ready for glassing as supplied. A shut-off actuator can be supplied as part of bellcrank assembly if required.

As I told you earlier, I can also supply spruce for leading/trailing edge etc. cut to any section size.
