Classic-FAI is scheduled for WA state champs in June. So bring your Classic racer along.






trying different engine combinations in preparation for their trip to the upcoming C/L World Championships in Poland.

One flight was enough to make Harry a happy boy so the model was put away ready for it's next competition at the South Australian State Championships in Monarto.

## Control-line incident from the past!

As I was born at a time when National Service in the UK was compulsory, I was called up to do my duty but, as I was serving a five year apprenticeship as an Industrial electrician, my call-up was deferred until I had turned 21. It was, therefore, 1960 when I received the summons.

After doing basic training at RAF Bridgenorth and then trade training at RAF Melksham I was posted to RAF Watton in Norfolk for the remainder of my compulsory two years service.

It so happened that the officer in charge of the base RAF Police (Rock-apes they were called) was one Pilot Officer Bird who I found out much, much later was the designer of beautiful flying wing gliders and had actually had plans printed in Aeromodeller.

Anyway, he was also in charge of the base model club which, at that time only had one other active member with me.

The RAFMAA held their own National Championship event at some time in the year and it was decided that four of us (two interested assistants) would accompany P.O Bird to compete in the 1961 event.

During the Nationals I was lucky enough to win Combat using an AM35 powered Mercury Monitor, gained 2<sup>nd</sup> place in Class B team-race and qualified for the final in Class A team-race (at that time called Davies A and forerunner of today's F2C models).

I cannot recall who else was in the final but I am pretty sure that Dick Place with a teammate called Arthur were the guilty parties. Dick became a very, very good friend later in life but I never did raise it with him.

It was in this final that the following incident occurred:

It was during one of my pit-stops, using squeeze bottles those days, that during flicking my ETA .15 something smashed into my forehead. Dazedly I saw another team-racer lying on top of mine. I remember just shoving it off and carrying on flicking but wondering where these red spots were coming from that were dripping onto my nice shiny wing! At that I just keeled over and knew no more until I woke up in the RAF Halton hospital.

The doctors there had to put five stiches into my forehead and I next woke up in the RAF Austin J2 transport vehicle on our way back to home base. They must have carried me into the vehicle. I guess these days I would have been held on hospital to check for concussion.

The officer said Congratulations to me to which I replied "What for?" He said, "Look on the back seat". There on the seat was a huge trophy on a plinth. It was the Victor Ludorum trophy and I had won it for the base for that year. Apparently the points that I had amassed were the highest.

The next day my forehead looked like overcooked bacon so it was off to Sick Quarters for me. They couldn't work out what had caused it and quizzed me about what was in the fuels. At that time I was using 10% Nitro Benzine as well as Amyl Nitrate but I don't know what was in the other model. Anyway, it peeled off in the next couple of days leaving a new pink skin. I was given a chit which read "This airman is excused from wearing a hat" and I really used that chit as long as I could get away with it.

I was told afterwards that on the other model, the Oliver Tiger engine had been held in with four 6BA brass bolts and that the impact had sheered them off. Wow that was a hard hit.

I hope that the current F2C fliers have a giggle over this but appreciate that we did not have safety helmets then and how important they are now.

PS: I was also lucky enough to meet and fly with Alex "RED" Phin who was based on an adjacent airfield at that time and we remain very good friends to this day.
