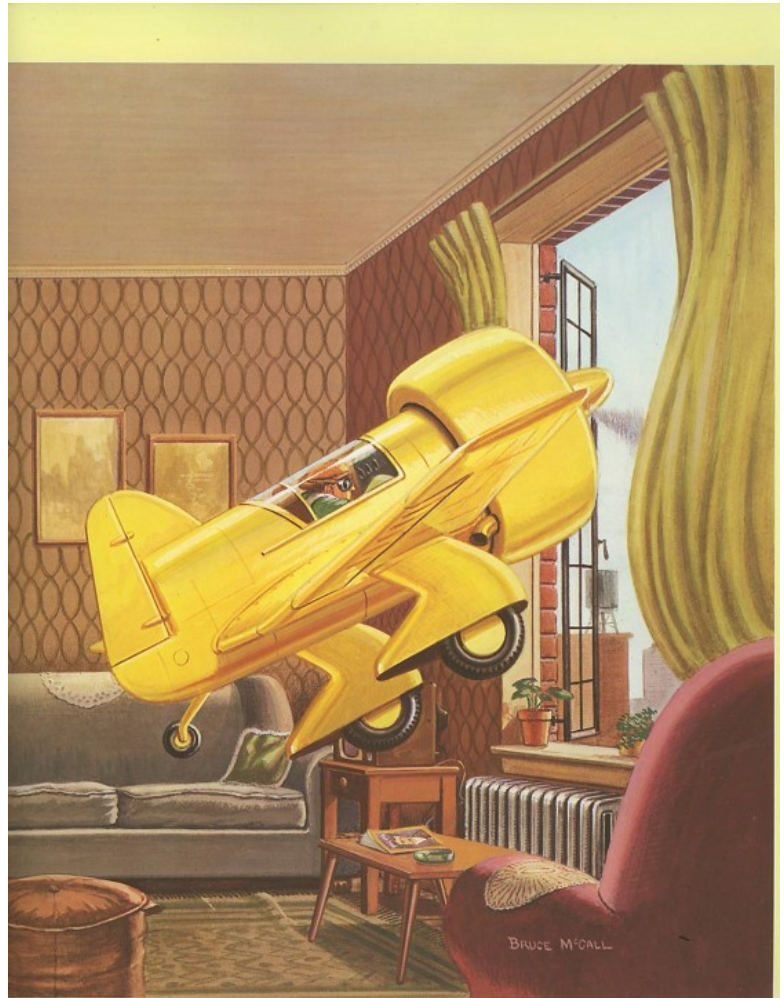

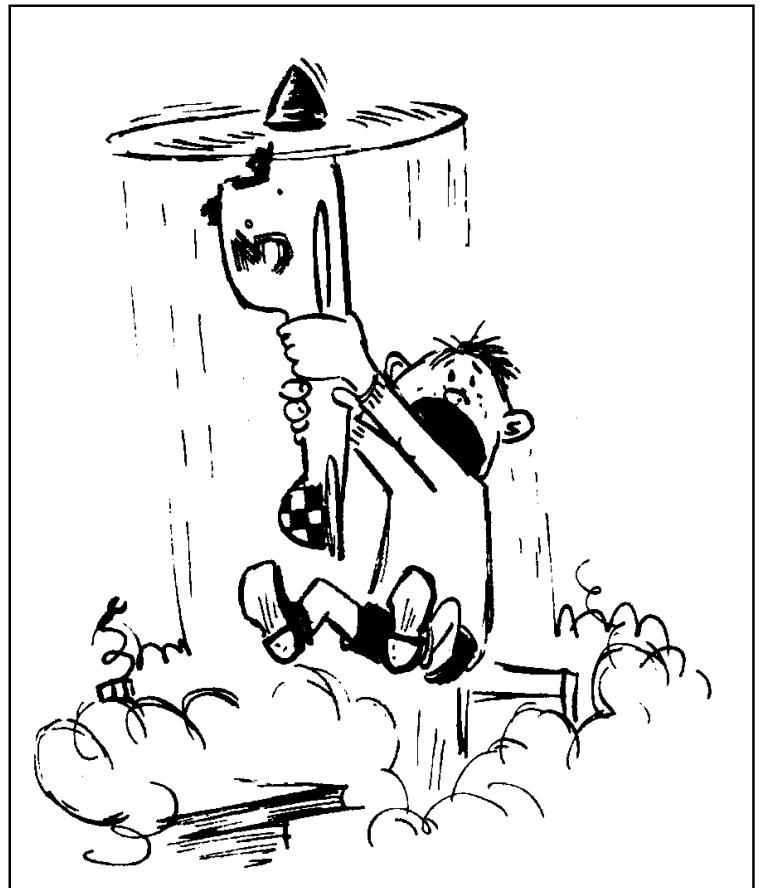

The Captain Airplane Kit could be constructed without tools or glue in a few pleasant hours. After all, Runciman had won his bet!





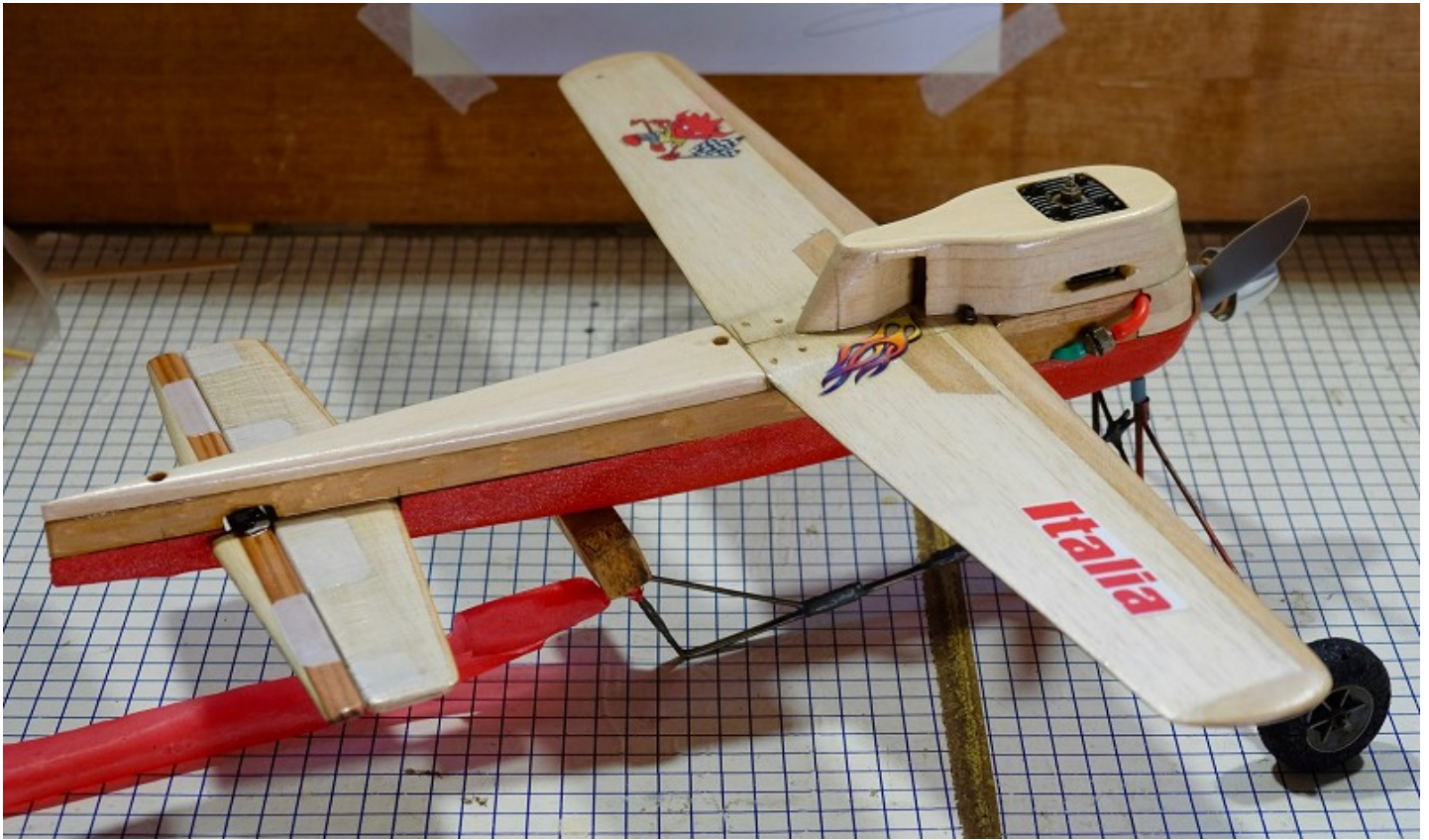
# AROUND THE CLUBS

No doubt vaccinated members will be flying first!

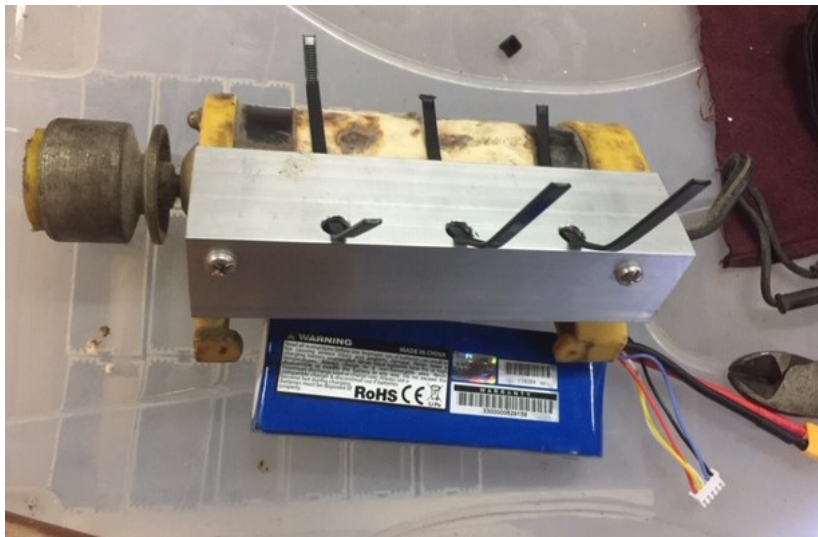
Here is a new speed model from John Nolan. That looks like a winner right there.

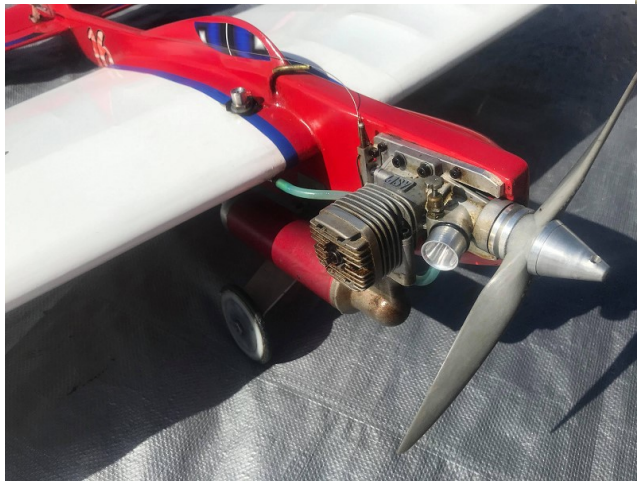
