Hi. Can anyone help.

Please have a look in your spares, thank you,

I have three engines in need of parts.

I have a Fuji .09 needing a spraybar & needle, I also have an OS PET .09 needing the same part, and finally I have a COX TD 09 which is missing the screw in venturi plus the spraybar block & needle.

All engines are in pretty good condition and could be useful to help newby members in time.

3-D printing of fuel tanks

This started out when I needed some vintage combat fuel tanks. I had soldered the tinplate together ready for the piping and decided to 3-D print a jig to bend the piping to the correct size and position.

I took so long to produce a jig that when I got back to the tinplate it had started to rust. It was then that I decided to print the tank, including the internal plumbing, in plastic.

No I'm not here to tell you how great 3-D printers are, but they do exist and these are my experiments with one. Here's a link to a guy that may convince you. https://www.youtube.com/c/TeachingTech/videos
I'm still a beginner at 3-D printing and the most common plastic used is PL A. I soon discovered that this is not suitable for glow fuel.




This is the result of glow fuel in the first PLA tank. The dark bits are the remains of finishing epoxy which I used in an attempt to seal the tank.

Some more testing was required and I discovered that PLA will handle diesel fuel. Further testing resulted in me discovering that slow set epoxy and medium cyano were not affected by diesel fuel either.

The search was on for a plastic suitable for glow fuel. This was PETG plastic. There may be others but this appears to work. Testing had shown that epoxy would not work inside a glow fuel tank.



The above pictures of the internal of the tank show the front feed and baffle, the finished tank, 90 degree bends of tubing glued in with cyano and small slow set epoxy seal for added measure.



This picture shows the uniflow pipe and top of the tank. It is a bit chunky but you have to consider how you print the object as you can't lay plastic on thin air.



This is the PETG tank for glow fuel which is a little harder to print than PLA.

In conclusion, what I have learnt so far is that:

- * The copper tubes should be drilled and fitted to the tank but not fixed.
- * Clean out any lose bits of plastic and glue the tank together with medium cyano.
- * The pipes can now be added, glued with medium cyano and sealed with epoxy.
- * When pressure testing the tank you may find some bubbles forming on the outside of the tank. I just smeared cyno on those are areas of the tank.

I tested the tank in a profile model powered by Enya 15 and am pleased to report success. However, the model went rich inverted. Now you would normally raise the tank but well known stunt flyer Peter White suggested lowering the uniflow pipe in the tank. This was done easily with the drawing and a new tank was printed for the following week. Problem solved!! I also pressure tested the tank after 4 weeks of use and it had no leaks. The only problem remaining is that there is no leaning of the tank to indicate nearing the end of the run. Just a consistent run and then it stops. (It could be the engine)


These are early days but it's a good start.
