

Despite the weather prediction of wind and rain, which caused the cancellation of the Carrier Deck competition, it turned out not that bad and we had a good speed comp on Sunday 21st May.

First up Murray flew his old very consistent OS .60 Class 3 mono line model on the large grass circle, last flight slightly under the record.

Next up, back on concrete was Tim Cooper with 3 good flights with his OS10FP 1/2A Proto, by trying a few props ended up going faster, that is what it is all about.

Ken also flew his 1/2A with Fora 09, was a bit over compressed then at the end of his flight clipped the ground breaking prop only.

Murray flew his 1/2A Proto with Jak 09 diesel for 3 even flights, the Jak or Cyclon seems to be the motor for 1/2A, the glow version a bit faster of the two. Harry flew his OS CZ 11PS Class 1, was going well until a sudden stop, it felt like a broken conrod and this was later confirmed. (Anybody out there with a piston liner assembly, let Harry know as they need replacing). This is the first rod I have heard of breaking in the 30+ years we have been running these motors in speed, mini-goodyear & pylon.

Tim then flew simple speed with a profile model and Magnum 15, once again trying different props. The last one of lower pitch could not get lean enough on ground and going rich in air, can easily be fixed by shifting tank

outboard.

Harry flew his "Long Gone" Classic B t/r in vintage proto to see if new head was any better, earlier in the day he bench ran and tachoed std setup and afterwards put another head with smaller bowl therefore more compression, was a lot better RPM only problem was it tended to oscillate on flick start which is no good for pit-stops in racing, so they added a few shims to get starts OK, he then put in the model and it went faster than normal.

Murray then had a flight with Novarossi .21 Class 5, then gave Mark a fly so he could sample a real model??!!!

Finally I gave Tim a flight of my very old Rossi Devil 1960 speed model with Enya 12 CX to give him a go at taking of from a dolly, all to gain experience.

Next comp he can fly my Rossi 60 mono-line. <u>Just JOKING !!!!!</u> Next comp is July 9th.

In 1987, Tom was entered into the MAAA Hall of Fame Honour Roll, "For success in competition and assistance to modellers for more than 30 years"



The VMAA will provide supplemental information as required.


I am happy to announce, at the conclusion of the council conference, the MAAA / VMAA has managed to maintain the current fee structure for 2023/2024.

To be able to keep the fees the same and continue to develop our sport is a major accomplishment. below to see the fees for 2023/2024.


